The armrests are always in leather.



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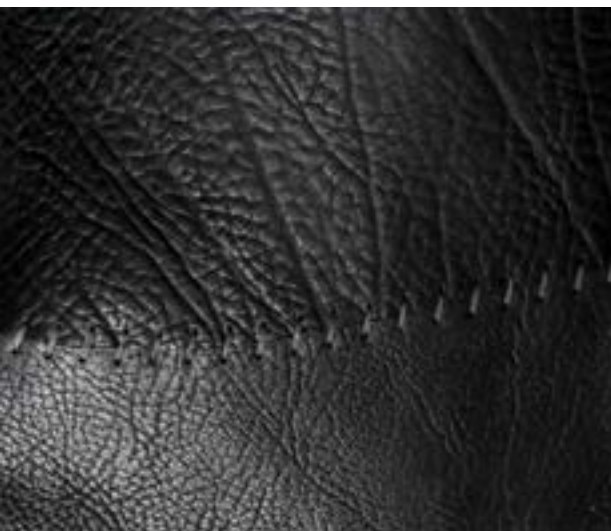
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## **MAONA unique**

From the concept of Mao piece for peace, comes a numbered series inspired by Peace: MAONA, unveiled here for the very first time. A striking ottoman measuring 210 cm in length, also made from wrinkled calf leather and entirely hand-stitched with waxed thread that echoes the language of healing and resilience.

A sculptural pouf dedicated to Peace, inspired by the conflicts around the world. Crafted from precious reclaimed wrinkled calf leather foreparts, each piece carries authentic marks—natural scars and imperfections—enhanced by bold hand stitching that evokes surgical sutures, transforming wounds into a powerful aesthetic statement.

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## **TRAMA** - big

designer Viola Tonucci

Large round pouf (approximately 1 meter in diameter) with an inverted cone shape, crafted in natural leather. Here, warp and weft intertwine in flowing curves, each individually shaped and hand woven by master artisans in the Marche region—creating a dynamic, sculptural surface.





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## VAGUE

designer Viola Tonucci

A mirror that can be a portal to an imaginary world, proposed for an extremely scenic furnishing . Its shape is organic and it reproduces the sea waves (hence the name). Its look is warm and enveloping thanks to its thick frame, covered with leather. The covering is customizable to the design of the interior designer. Dimensions: cm 120 x h 200

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## THE STUDIO

We are a company with a history of design and production of sustainable and high quality handcrafted furnishing. Tonucci Collection is a brand of Tonucci Design studio. Tonucci Design was founded in 1970, when Enrico Tonucci started his design business for major Italian and foreign furnishing companies, gaining an extremely significant experience first as a designer and then as an entrepreneur, when he founded and directed his own companies, Triangolo, Arte Cuoio and Teatro delle Muse. Viola Tonucci got her college degree at Urbino Art School Scuola del Libro and then her master degree at led in Milan, graduating in graphic design and industrial design for jewellery; she started her collaboration with the studio in 2004, she became partner in the business in 2012 and in 2022 she acquired a controlling stake and took over the leadership of the brand. Today the team is made up of a handful of trusted collaborators who complete the sales and production department.



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### **ENRICO TONUCCI designer**

Graduated at the College of Arts, in Porta Romana, Florence. Since 1970 he has been working works as designer and artistic advisor, for Italian and foreign enterprises, teaming up with international architects and well-known companies. In 1976 he started Triangolo, a design experimental laboratory where he designed and produced high quality furniture and complements inspired by the northern Europe style mixed with the Mediterranean spirit; Triangolo eventually left behind its lab structure to become a real enterprise. In 1992 Enrico Tonucci bought-out Arte&Cuoio taking over the direction of the company; both his companies had great success in Europe and in the world. In 2003 became Art Director for Curvet Environments SpA. Group, a company that, together with important brands such as Simon, Triangolo, Arte& cuoio, R.S.V.P., Sica, and Zeritalia formed an important point of reference for the "made in Italy" produced in Pesaro.

In 2005, he left Curvet Ambienti in order to focus on research and design. In 2006 he founded Manifestodesign, a studio brand with a collection of unique products, all handcrafted in Italy and made of first-quality all natural materials. In his career Enrico has been awarded with many prestigious prizes, recognitions and Institutional assignments. He lives and works in Pesaro.

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**VIOLA TONUCCI designer**

Graduated at the “ Scuola del Libro” High School in Urbino she got a full scholarship at the European institute of Design in Milan, achieving a diploma in jewellery art. Afterwards, she attended the TAM sculpture and jewellery course presided by Arnaldo Pomodoro and directed by Eliseo Mattiacci. Her first work experience was with architecture and furnishings Studio Branco in Milan.

Viola collaborated as designer with some jewellery companies in Milan among which Anaconda. Since 2003 she has been designing for the furnishing business becoming partner of the Tonuccidesign Studio in Pesaro. She designed for Italian and foreign companies such as Manifestodesign, Estel Group, Casanova, Tonelli Design, Okite, and others, also collaborating with other important designers, from time to time.

She takes part in collective jewellery and design shows for which she has received very positive reviews and even been awarded with the honourable mention at the Young & Design Competition.

Some of his projects are exhibited in prestigious foundations and galleries and chosen to set up important public places such as the lounge of MOMA Modern Art Museum in San Francisco, USA.
